## Curatorial Statement

*Doppelgänger* is a Georgia State University undergraduate students' exhibition from the Selected Topics in Drawing and Painting course guided by professor Jiha Moon. This project examines each student's self-reflection during the Covid-19 pandemic. Each student has created a self-portrait mask and painted interpretation of that mask.

As we introspect with excitement and trepidation, we choose which parts of ourselves to bring into the public eye. Months of isolation have strengthened our respective relationships with our surroundings so much that home now feels like an inherent part of one's being. Rather than an intermittent resting spot, the home is an extension of ourselves and our personalities, each window, and door a different perspective onto the world.

These masks are different selves or "homes" we are built to understand our current inner world. Some are reinforced for interactions with strangers, some are readied for dealing with everyday racism, some are decorated for celebrations with friends and family, some are readied for growth in a world that has been reshaped by loss. Each mask has its own specific use, and helps us find our way in an uncertain, strange new normal.

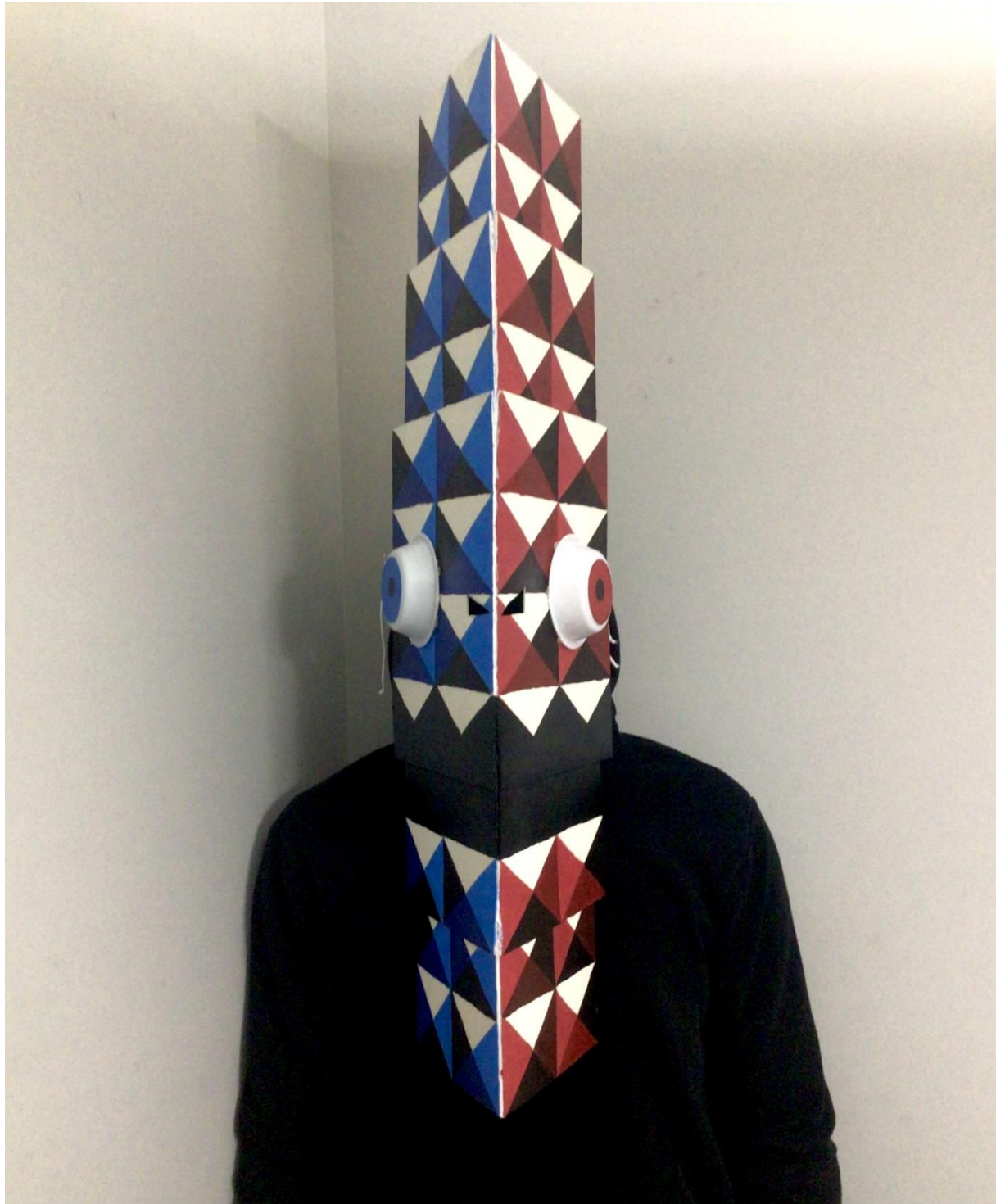
